Speaker Session #1... Professionalism: The Good, the Bad, and the Ugly **Julie Curry, FSA, MAAA, Curry Actuarial Services, LLC**

Julie's presentation will cover an overview of the professional code of conduct and actuarial standards of practice, as well as a high level discussion of cases in which actuaries were disciplined by the Actuarial Board of Conduct and Discipline.

Julie incorporated her company in July 2000 to provide actuarial consulting services to the life insurance industry and insurance regulators. Julie has 26 years of life insurance industry financial reporting experience with emphasis on statutory, US GAAP, tax, and international GAAP accounting; auditing; conversions to US GAAP; insurance examinations and regulatory services; reengineering financial reporting processes; and valuation systems conversions. Ms. Curry is a Fellow of the Society of Actuaries and a Member of the American Academy of Actuaries.

Speaker Session #2... Health Care Reform: What was in the bill and what can we expect?

Jim Galasso, FSA, MAAA, CERA, President and Consulting Actuary, Actuarial Modeling

Jim's presentation will cover the impact of recent landmark health care legislation.

Mr. Galasso, a Fellow of the Society of Actuaries, a Member of the American Academy of Actuaries, and a Chartered Enterprise Risk Analyst, has over 30 years of experience in the health insurance and managed care industry.

During different phases of Jim's career, he served as both the Chief Actuary and Chief Financial Officer of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Florida and the MetLife Insurance Company's Group Department. Serving in various capacities, Jim managed a wide range of functions including: Actuarial, Underwriting, Financial Planning, Accounting, Expense Management, Treasury, Tax Compliance, and Internal Audit.

Prior to incorporating Actuarial Modeling in 2000 and serving as President & Consulting Actuary, Jim was also a Partner with Ernst & Young LLP, managing E&Y's Southeast actuarial healthcare practice.
